- ⇒ Riders under age 18 must have a parent or guardian present to sign a release waiver.
- ⇒ Horses known to kick must wear a red tail ribbon, which will be provided.
- ⇒ We encourage you to use an ASTM riding helmet.
- ⇒ Please ride to help ensure the safety of everyone.
